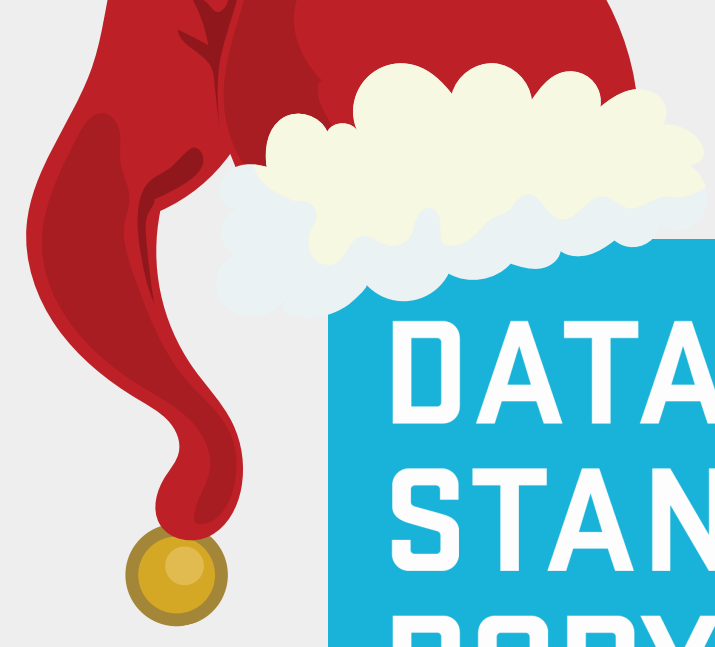

DP162 & DP222 (1st iteration)

Consultation closes on 30 November 2021

DP162 relates to Consumer Experience Standards for Joint Accounts.
DP222 outlines options for ADRs to make clear what an insight would reveal or describe, options for ADRs to notify consumers when disclosing data from the CDR environment and existing CX standards that would apply to insight and trusted adviser disclosure consents.

01 March 2022
Pending approval from Chair. Potential FDO.

DP225
Consultation closes on 18 February 2022
DP225 presents a set of questions for the consideration if and how security standards should apply to data recipient access arrangements. This consultation does not propose standards, instead it asks for feedback on need, feasibility and implementation considerations.
